This is one of my favorite volumes to play through. It is a very nice edition to play through for sight reading. The pieces all are truly of easy grade. The quality of the book is good, with clear, dark printing. I enjoy the unique feature of being able to play pieces that span several centuries all in one volume. It really is a miniature education in music to learn of the large number of composers and the great variety of styles they possessed. All of the pieces selected are quality compositions, and many are enjoyable enough to go back to many times. So you are getting a lot in one compact volume. Highly recommended. This book is full beautiful classical songs for beginner pianists. It's even fun for the more advanced student as very little practice is needed in order to play them.
