Zootopia is one of the best movies for me this year and it's only March. This companion artbook too is a gem. This wonderful 160-page hardcover artbook features the concept art for the characters, environments and props that make up the world of Zootopia. If you thought that the city was busy with so many things going on, well, this book will delight you with additional environments and characters that weren't even included in the film. The artworks are so beautiful. I love character designs and the variety. The artists really nailed the look and in the film, the animation is done so well, so believable. I've so many favourite characters, Judy, Nick, Sloth, Boggo, Clawhauser, Yax, Gazelle and the dancing tigers, and of course Mr Big and many more. LOL. I can't praise all the artists enough. Some of the highlights to me are drawings from Matthias Lechner, Cory Loftis, David Goetz and even the co-director Bryon Howard is also a fantastic artist. There are many environment artworks included, some presented with breathtaking details and oh so beautiful lighting. You get to read about the effort and thought that goes into the production and design of everything that's

shown on screen. All the boroughs and locations are included, namely Downtown, Rainforest District, Savanna Central, Little Rodentia, Sahara Square, Tundratown and Cliffside. And there are several pages of discarded art for an amusement park and a stadium. This book is just packed with wonderful art like how Zootopia is filled with so much life. Art of Zootopia is a fantastic book. 5 stars for the book itself. Unfortunately, the image quality of the ebook version is absolutely unacceptable. The pictures are very small and terribly compressed. Most of the text in the images is completely unreadable. The pictures are just a blurry mess of JPEG artifacts. Even if you view the full-size image by long-pressing on the picture, the quality is still the same. I understand that they wanted to keep the filesize of the book small, but unfortunately they completely destroyed the thousands of beautiful images in this book in pursuit of that goal. If you want to get an idea of how pathetic the ebook looks, look at the sample images you get when you click on the book's cover at the top of the page. The actual ebook is nearly that bad. If a new edition of the ebook is released with image quality comparable to the print edition, I will happily buy this again and give the book 5 stars. But until then, I can't recommend the Kindle edition to anyone.

Got the Kindle version, since the hardcover is out of stock (and looks like it'll stay that way for a while), but the really awful compression makes it absolutely worthless. Bought the storybook for my nephew last week, and while not perfect, the pictures were beautiful. This one is just plain awful. Wish I could get a refund on it.

When I buy art books I normally buy the physical hard copy of it; with this I took a chance and preordered the ebook expecting it to be something more HD that would allow me to zoom in and get a good look at all the details while saving precious space on my shelf. Unfortunately, that was not what I got and instead I had the dubious honor of paying money to look at shrunken down, poorly compressed artwork that looked like it had lost a fight or three with the image converter. It's a shame because the art in this book is very good and deserves to be seen in a crisp, clear format and not something muddied like what you'd find on a fansite in the early 2000s. Unless you have a taste for the badly-compressed jpeg aesthetic, I would recommend that you not buy the ebook version and pay the extra money to get the hard copy instead. Your eyes will thank you.

I got my book the other day, and I'm absolutely blown away with how beautiful this book is. All the illustrations are crisp and stunningly well done. Highly recommend it to anyone who's a fan of the movie. Just make sure you skip the Kindle version.-- Old Kindle version review --I've got the actual book on order, but that might be a while off, so I jumped at the chance to buy the kindle version to get a nice early peek at the wonderful illustrations inside. Sadly nearly all the illustrations are of a poor jpeg like quality. Some are so bad they are nearly unreadable.I'm incredibly sad I wasted \$16 on this inferior version.

If you wanted more of Zootopia, Tundratown, Sahara Square, Little Rodentia, Burrowborough etc. This book is what you need! Zootopia, produced by Walt Disney Animation Studios, and distributed by Walt Disney Pictures. Co-directed by Byron Howard (Tangled, Bolt), Rich Moore (Wreck-It Ralph) and Jared Bush (Penn Zero: Part-Time Hero), and produced by Clark Spencer (Lilo & Stitch, Wreck-It Ralph, and Bolt). Their films just keep getting better, and better, and this book is a reflection of that. The thought of every little detail.
