

I only received a summary of the first four chapters out of 17. I saw this nowhere in the description or customer reviews. Also, it was full of grammatical errors. Did something go wrong with my download?

Kindle seems to have opened up a market for students to sell their papers and creative writing projects for cash. Mr. Cooper's article is poorly written and is not a serious analysis of the subject matter. It is an attempt to make a quick buck and is an amazing scam.

The result of my purchase was disappointing. The narrative and analysis stop long before a satisfactory resolution is reached. I am aware that this is a Summary and Analysis; in truth, it is nothing near what I understood the promotional paragraphs to claim. The material that downloaded to my Kindle Fire is truncated, such that the story hangs in several parts in limbo! Thus, the money I spent for this item, based on .com promotional paragraphs, has been substantially wasted! I tried to contact .Com to ask if the material downloaded is what was intended or was there a preparation, promotion, or transmission mistake. I have been stymied in my efforts in that arena, too. Alas!

Anthony Doerr is a wonderful author and he is known to be detailed and complex with his themes and small ideas. I think it is wonderful that this summary doesn't give too much away but honestly does amazing justice to an amazing book. This was a great supplemental book.
