This is just the actual raw standard, not the handbook. Unless you are a lawyer or an expert in the code already, you will probably want to get the handbook which has illustrations, explanations, and commentary.

This is not what I was expecting when I ordered this book. Of the choices given, hardcover, paperback, and ring, I interpreted ring to mean spiral bound. This is a 3 ring binder with loose pages; the description should be made more clear to note this. This will not hold up well on the jobsite without re-inforcing every page.

This should be required for anyone doing any type of electrical work, from the licensed professional to the residential do-it-yourselfer. If you are the latter, (or an apprentice) you may need to buy the "skeleton key" illustrated guide that is available under separate title with every update of the NEC, which happens every 3 years.

Great condition, no problems at all. I needed the NEC for an electrical construction class, and even though this isn't the latest edition, it suited my needs. I would recommend saving money and buying the second or third most recent edition of the NEC (updated every 3 years, I believe). The changes are so minuscule between each edition, so an older copy is fine.
