

Only 2,000 copies of the original book were printed before the lithographic plates were destroyed in the London Blitz during World War II. As a result, it has become one of the most collectible of all artistâ <sup>TM</sup>s books from this period. This beautiful facsimile edition features Raviliousâ <sup>TM</sup>s illustrations in exquisite color and includes an essay by V&A curator Gill Saunders, putting the book and its history into context.
