

Well-produced version of this theatre standard. At first, I was dubious about Calista Flockhart's performance, but she really grew in presence as the play went on (much like Nora herself.) The play itself is showing it's age. It's out of step with today's modern tastes and subtle characterizations, but it's silly to judge art with the benefit of history. 'A Doll's House' is Ibsen's second-best masterpiece, and mandatory reading/watching for all theatre lovers.

This was well performed. I listened to this on Audible as I was working on a quilt and really loved how the actor's portrayed the characters with such passion. It was a wonderful drama, though sad as well. It definitely was about women empowerment and was advanced for its time. Basically a
