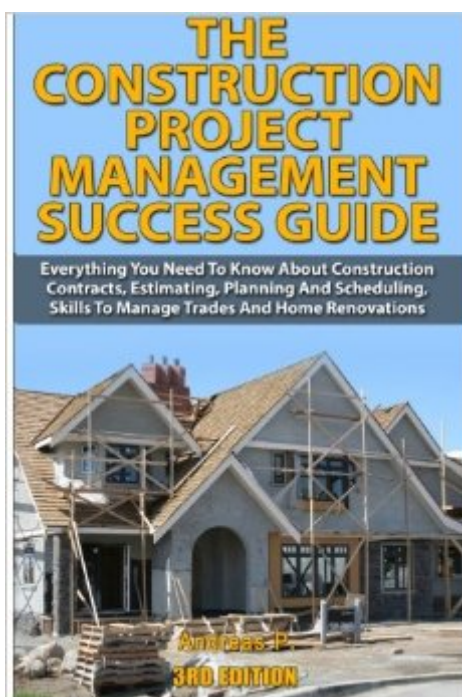

Although this book is directed just as much at project managers, I found it to be a real eye-opener as a homeowner. It's unfortunate that the construction industry, particularly as it relates to home building, has gotten a reputation for dishonesty or at least extreme time inefficiency. I think these things can be fixed in part by educating current and future homeowners on the basics of what is involved from the project manager's perspective. This book is a great first step in filling that gap in our knowledge.

This book is great for do it yourself projects such as home renovation, estimations, and the ins and outs of the guidelines and permits required to complete a major project.
