

Has your career path put you in a position where you need to know how to use AutoCAD? If it has, then this book is for you. Authors Bill Fane and David Byrnes, have done an outstanding job of writing a book that truly gets you going quickly with AutoCAD.Authors Fane and Byrnes, begin by

helping you ease into how to use AutoCAD to create engineering drawings and how to get started. In addition, they help you discover the half-dozen commands that account for much of your AutoCAD activities. The authors also expose you to the big picture, from start to finish; and, how to start a drawing to printing it. Then, they continue by correctly showing you how to set up AutoCAD and create templates to have drawing success. The authors then help you navigate through your drawing, by panning and zooming. Next, they help you draw linear things with the AutoCAD drawing commands; line up for lines and polylines; and, close up with rectangles and ploygons. In addition, the authors describe how you can round the curves with circles, arcs, splines, and clouds; employ eccentric ellipses; dunk for donuts; and make your points. In addition, they show you how to type coordinates at the keyboard; get to know the AutoCAD coordinate systems; snap to object features; and, use other precision drawing and editing techniques. The authors also introduce you to object properties: One set of AutoCAD tools and techniques that can help prevent you from making CAD messes. Then, they continue by showing you how to use command-first editing; select objects with maximum flexibility; and, edit with grips. The authors then introduce you to the primary edit commands in AutoCAD. Next, they explain how to set up layouts in paper space for efficient plotting.
