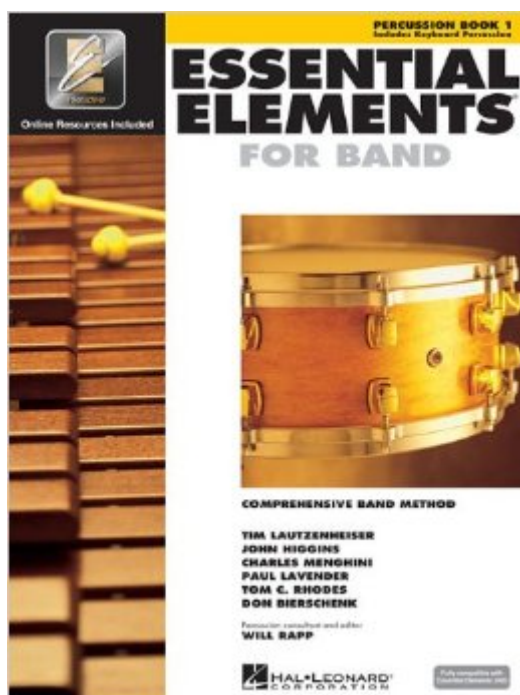

We bought this book because it is the one used by my child's fourth grade band program, and it seems well suited to that age and older. The book covers the beginning fundamentals for snare drum, bass drum and bells/xylophone. The snare and bass exercises comprise the first half of the book and are written together, on one staff. The bells exercises make up the second half of the book. Exercises are short, 1-2 lines of music, and fundamentals are explained clearly before each segment. Although this may be outside its scope, it would be fun for kids of this age if some of the music were simple versions of rock classics, instead of all folk songs and classical.

The Essential Elements 2000 book, is a great book for anybody who wants to learn how to play any percussion instrument. I advise this book for everybody. It comes with a DVD which is very helpful and nice. The book contains a lot of captivating songs and I fully enjoy playing them.

I purchased this band book because it is required by my sons school for beginning band. I believed that this came with a dvd, but it comes with a download instead. It was slightly misleading which is the reason I rated this four instead of five stars. I like the techniques used inside the book for new band students.
