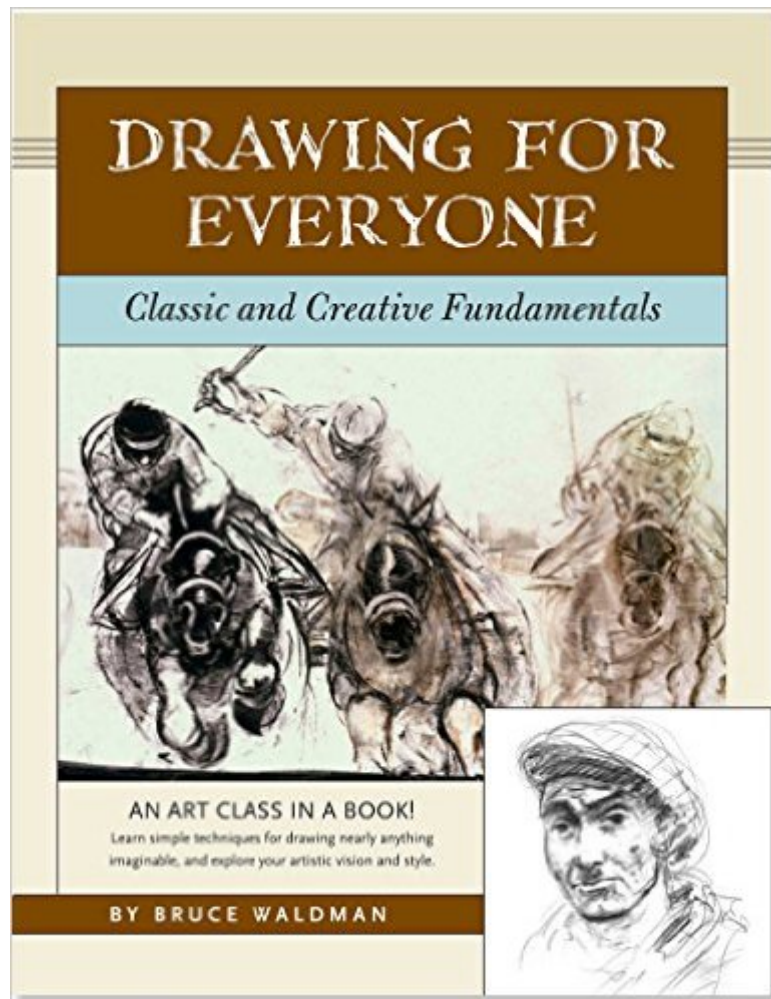

If you go to any bookstore or library--provided you still do that sort of thing (sorry)--you will find a tomb of failed drawing books. Shelves upon shelves of manuals that profess to be able to help you learn the art and craft of drawing but which fall miserably short. Frequently it is because the author doesn't actually know how to draw themselves, or, if they do know how to draw, they don't know how to teach; and if they do know how to teach and draw the book is poorly produced causing you to lose the vitality of both the draftsmanship and didacticism. But every so often you find a gem. A book created by a master draftsman and a master teacher. One that deserves to be used, perused, looked at, learned from and cherished. "Drawing for Everyone" is just such a book. In the large library of drawing books I have on my shelf it holds its weight with the time tested giants created by the likes of Andrew Loomis, George Bridgman and Robert Beverly Hale. (It is worth mentioning that Mr. Waldman was a student of Hale's). The book truly is a classic.

This is the best drawing book I have seen including ones I have used in drawing classes. The author/artist uses his own finished artwork to illustrate in clear and concise steps how to approach drawing like the great masters. He makes it interesting and fun and can be used by beginners or more advanced artists. Unique to this book is the depth of addressing how to capture emotion in portraiture. This is a high quality book for a really good price.

Beautifully illustrated and inspiring. Drawing for Everyone is so clearly written and organized, it will appeal to the beginner who is just getting started as well as the seasoned pro who is looking for a different approach to her/his work. Sprinkled throughout the book are Bruce Waldman's etchings and monotypes which show the range of effects that can be achieved once you go beyond the more ubiquitous pencil/charcoal/conté approach that is used for drawing practice. Mr. Waldman takes the reader way beyond the usual approach in drawing books and offers a rich and diverse range of drawing experiences that mix fundamental exercises with drawing techniques that lead to endless approaches and possibilities.
